Lesson 4 - Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath 耶稣是安息日的主

Vocabulary for today:

- 1. fasting (verb) going without food or eating for a period of time 禁食
- 2. bridegroom (noun) a man who is getting married 新郎
- 3. unshrunk (adjective) a piece of cloth that is new and has not shrunk—gotten smaller 没有缩小的(新的)
- 4. garment (noun) a piece of clothing 衣服; 服装
- 5. wineskins (noun) a leather bag that held wine, similar to a bottle does today (羊皮制作的)葡萄酒袋
- 6. burst (verb) a tear something open suddenly 爆裂
- 7. grainfields (noun) fields planted with grains like wheat or barley 麦田
- 8. unlawful (adjective) something that is against the law 非法的
- 9. Sabbath (noun) Saturday, the Jewish day for worship and rest in the 3rd commandment 安息日
- 10. **consecrated** (adjective) something set aside for a special purpose 神圣的;供神用的
- 11. **synagogue** (noun) like a church, a gathering place for Jews to worship (犹太) 会堂
- 12. shrivelled (adjective) something dried up or withered and useless (usually to plants) 枯干的;枯萎的
- 13. to accuse (verb) to charge someone with fault or find fault with someone 指责; 控告
- 14. stubborn (adjective) a hard or fixed opinion and unwilling to change 顽固的; 固执的
- 15. to stretch (verb) to extend or hold something out 伸展; 伸直
- 16. impure (adjective) something unclean or evil 不洁的

Mark 2:18-22 - Jesus' breaks the fasting tradition 耶稣打破了禁食的传统

1. In this section we hear that it was common practice for the Jews to fast. Jesus, however, does not make his disciples fast. What did other people think of this?

Mark 2:23-28 - Jesus breaks the Sabbath tradition 耶稣打破了安息日的传统

4. In this section we hear that the Pharisees had many strict rules about what the Jews could do on the Sabbath. What did they think of Jesus' disciples breaking their traditions about not working? 在这一节中,我们了解到,法利赛人对犹太人在安息日的行为有严格的规定。他们如何看待耶稣的门徒打破在安息日不工作的传统?

5. What were God's commands for the Sabbath? (Look at Genesis 2:2-3 & Exodus 20:8-11) 神对安息日的诫命是什么? (查阅创世记 2: 2-3 & 出埃及 20: 8-11)

6. What was Jesus trying to teach them (and us) about the true purpose of the Sabbath? 关于安息日的真正目的, 耶稣想教导他们(和我们)的是什么?

Mark 3:1-6 - Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath 耶稣是安息日的主

7. In this section we hear that Jesus' enemies were hoping to catch him breaking the Sabbath traditions by healing a man who had a deformed hand. What were they guilty of doing? 在本节中,我们了解到耶稣的敌人希望通过耶稣在安息日医治了一个手有残疾的人来指责他打破了安息日的传统。他们(指耶稣的敌人)犯了什么罪?

8. Look back at verse 27 - how does Jesus show us here that he is the Son of God? What does he say the true purpose of the Sabbath is?

9. How do people keep the "Sabbath" today? (Colossians 2:16-17) 现在,人们如何守安息日的诫命? (查阅歌罗西书 2:16-17)
